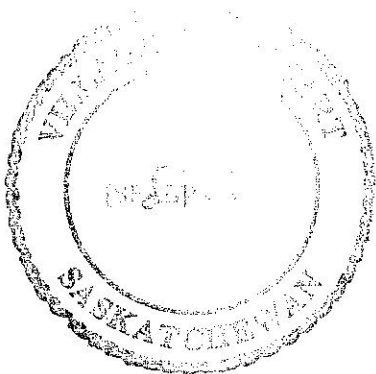


# Sewer Line Blockage Policy

## Village of Dysart Policy 2013-02

The Council of the Village of Dysart in the Province of Saskatchewan approves the following policy for Sewer Line Blockages:

1. In this policy,
  - a) "administrator" means the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "council" means the council of the municipality; and
  - c) "Municipality" means the Village of Dysart.
2. Council will only consider sewer line blockages that occur on Village Property for reimbursement.
3. If blockages occur between 8am – 5pm Tuesday through Friday the Village Maintenance Man may be called in evaluate the blockage. The Village of Dysart may complete the sewer cleaning work at a minimum fee of \$150.00. The Village shall advise the homeowner of the fee prior to completing the work.
4. All blockages cleaned by plumbers and if the Village is thought to be held responsible, a camera must be used to determine the nature of the blockage. A representative from the Village of Dysart must be present to confirm the nature of the blockage.
5. If the nature of the blockage cannot be determined by the plumber or village representative, the homeowner is responsible for all costs incurred.
6. As tree roots are on both sides of the property line, a maximum of 50% of the rebate of the invoice maybe eligible for reimbursement by resolution of council. If the tree roots are only on village property, the council may by resolution approve 100% of the rebate.
7. Small sags in the pipeline are not deemed to be cause for blockage or reimbursement of a claim.
