Yard Debris and Compost Policy

Village of Dysart Policy 2013-03

The Council of the Village of Dysart in the Province of Saskatchewan approves and enacts the following policy for Yard Debris and Compost Policy:

- 1. In this policy,
 - a) "administrator" means the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "council" means the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" means the Village of Dysart.
 - d) "Yard Debris and Compost" means all natural materials that can be composted, such as but not limited to, tree and hedge clippings, tree branches, leaves, weeds, lawn clippings and garden waste.
- 2. Yard Debris and Compost will be accepted by the Village of Dysart transfer station free of charge.
- 3. The Village of Dysart maintenance man will pick up these materials free of charge in the spring for a week and the fall for a week with dates determined by council.
- 4. All materials left for maintenance man to pick up must adhere to the following or the materials will not be picked up;
 - Yard debris must be bagged in biodegradable/compostable bags.
 - Bags cannot weigh more than 50lbs.
 - Yard debris can also be placed in garbage containers and must weigh no more than 50lbs.
 - Small tree branches or limbs must be bundled in 3 foot lengths and weigh no more than 50lbs.
- 5. The Village of Dysart may also by discretion; of the maintenance man, Administrator or Council; pickup these materials free of charge after a storm that has damaged trees in the village where branches have broken and fallen and need removal.
- 6. Any resident of the Village of Dysart may haul their own yard debris to the transfer station free of charge. Transfer station keys are available at the Village Office during normal business hours.
- 7. If a resident requests yard debris to be picked up by the maintenance man other than the predetermined dates the fee is \$10.00 per trip to the transfer station. Please call or visit the Village office for details, payment and to schedule a time for pickup.
