Bylaw No. 05/14

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DYSART IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE THE FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF THE TRANSFER STATION

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Dysart operates a transfer station located at the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 10 – 23 – 15- W2, Surface Parcel #131756452;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dysart deems it appropriate to charge fees for the use of the Transfer Station.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Dysart hereby enacts as follows:

 That the following shall be the charges paid in advance to the Office of the Village of Dysart for the use of the Transfer Station.

½ ton load or trailer equivalent	\$25.00 per load
1 ton truck	\$50.00
2 ton truck	\$75.00
3 ton truck	\$100.00
Tandem Truck	\$125.00
Semi load	\$325.00

IF YOUR LOAD OF GARBAGE FILLS UP THE BIN THEN IT IS A \$60.00 MINUMIM CHARGE. MAINTENANCE FOREMAN WILL CHECK LARGE LOADS DELIVERED TO BINS.

There will be no charge for large trees', branches and clean lumber (unpainted and untreated wood free from nails, screws or bolts) and they shall be placed on the burn pile.

There will be no charge for compostable materials such as grass, leaves, mulch, small tree clippings, branches and clean soil. These items must be removed from plastic bags and are to be placed on the compost pile at transfer station.

DYSART TRANSFER STATION SHALL NOT ACCEPT TIRES, VEHICLES, PESTICIDES OR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS, HAZARDOUS WASTE, ANIMAL CARCASSES OR SEWAGE.

THE TRANSFER STATION MAY ONLY BE USED BY THE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF DYSART.

Residents wishing to use the station must come to the Village Office and shall pay the appropriate fees' in advance, and fill out a declaration; see schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw. A key will be issued to the resident to haul the material to the transfer station, unless the items are to be picked up by the Village Maintenance Man. If the Village Maintenance Man is available he will accompany the resident to the transfer station and direct the user to dispose of the items in the proper designated areas. If the Village Maintenance Man is unavailable, the user will dispose of the materials in the designated areas at their discretion. After disposal, the key shall be returned to the Village Office.

Failure to comply with the above fees' and unauthorized hauling of material shall result in a penalty of \$100.00 (one hundred dollars), plus the cost of the fees' of the unauthorized material hauled to the transfer station. Unpaid fees' and fines that are outstanding by December 31 of the current year shall be applied to the tax roll and subject to a 12% penalty.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect January 1, 2015.
